About Sexual Assault Response Teams (SART)

SARTs use a multidisciplinary approach to investigate and treat victims of sexual violence. SARTs may consist of law enforcement, advocates, prosecutors, crime lab, and the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner.

SARTs across the country have proven to increase reporting and conviction rates in states where these models have been in place.

Utilizing a victim centered approach provides the victim with compassionate, efficient and highly skilled care and support throughout the criminal justice process.

The advanced training that SART members receive, along with adherence to protocol guidelines, greatly improves the quality of evidence collected, which strengthens evidence admissibility in court.

About Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANE)

A SANE is a registered nurse who has received advanced education and training regarding sexual assault and forensic nursing. The SANE completes a medico-legal examination, collects and preserves evidence, applies critical thinking skills, and can be considered an expert witness in the judicial system.

SANE credentials are issued by the Kentucky Board of Nursing to registered nurses who complete this 40-hour didactic course and also complete the 60-hour clinical requirements within nine months. For information contact KASAP's Statewide SANE/SART Coordinator or the Kentucky Board of Nursing.
